Once again, the Fraser Valley Symphony is proud to be holding a Student Solo Competition. The winner(s) of this competition will perform the work with which they competed at a concert with the Fraser Valley Symphony in January, 2012.

The Competition is open to those who meet the following requirements:

- must be between the ages of 13 and 21 as of Dec. 31, 2011
- must be a resident of, or studying at a music school in, one of the following areas:
Abbotsford / Aldergrove / Fort Langley / Langley / Matsqui / Mission
Sumas

Students should be at an advanced level of study.

The competition will take place Sunday, October 30, 11:00 am, at Langley Community Music School. Students are asked to perform either a short work(s), or one movement of a work, not less than 5 minutes, and total time not to exceed 15 minutes. Music should be memorized, and a copy of the piano music or orchestral score provided for the adjudicators. Competitors must provide their own accompanist. Please limit choices to the standard repertoire, or contact us to have your repertoire approved.

Applications are available from your teacher and/or music school office. Completed applications are to be mailed to the Fraser Valley Symphony and must be received by **Friday, October 14, 2011**. Late applications may not be accepted. Applications must be accompanied by a \$20, non-refundable fee.

Winners will need to attend two or three Monday evening rehearsals with the orchestra to prepare.
